The Offeror shall indicate on the appropriate Price Schedule the unit prices (where applicable) and total quotation price of the goods it proposes to supply under the contract.

Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be delivered duty paid (DDP) prices. The quoted price shall include all Govt. applicable taxes, and supply and installation charges.

Prices shall be quoted in Pak Rupees and shall be fixed during the performance of contract.

In the case of a Offeror offering to supply goods under the contract which the Offeror did not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Offeror has been duly authorized by the goods' Manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in the Purchaser's country;.
