It was decided that FBR registration is mandatory and KPRA Registration provisionally allowed but successful bidder shall register with KPRA accordingly before the signing of the contract.

Whereas, all other Terms & Conditions, Specifications, Rules and Clauses of bidding document/RFPs shall remain the same.
